

Brookdale Elementary School's 2014 – 2015 Dress Code

Unified Dress Code Policy for Brookdale Elementary School

Bottoms:

Solid khaki, black or navy blue pants, jumpers, skorts, skirts, capris, and shorts.

Jeans are ONLY allowed on days designated by the principal.

Pants must be of appropriate size, worn as designed and of ankle length. Pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed.

Belts MUST be worn if there are belt loops on the pants.

Skirts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee.

Skirts cannot have any slits or openings.

Tops:

Solid white, yellow, light blue, gold, lavender, pink, and black polo shirts.

Polo shirts can be long sleeve or short sleeve.

Polo shirts must have a collar.

All shirts must be of appropriate size.

Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath polo shirts, school t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters.

Shoes and Socks:

All shoes must have closed toes and backs.

Shoes may be of any color with properly sized and secured shoe laces.

Shoes with lights or wheels ARE NOT allowed.

Socks must be worn.

Any item of clothing prohibited by the Bibb County Board of Education as documented in the Guidelines for Student Success is also prohibited by Brookdale Elementary.
